Two years after the Paris Agreement, and following COP 23, this conference will present three points of view – from CIRED, the IPCC and EDF - on how to fill the remaining gap with the long-term objectives of the Agreement.

Céline GIVARCH, *economist at CIRED*, will show research results of the GICN (an interdisciplinary group of researchers working on climate negotiations) quantifying the gap between States' pledges and trajectories compatible with the 2°C objective.

Roland SÉFÉRIAN, *climatologist at Météo-France and IPCC member*, will introduce the special report of the IPCC on the impacts of an 1.5°C global warming.

Jean-Michel TROCHET, *senior economist, Innovation Strategy and Planning Division at EDF*, will build upon the IEA scenarios to discuss world energy and economic impacts of climate policies.
